VOLUNTEER DRIVER

Linck serves the children and families of the Chatham-Kent Municipality and includes child protection, children's mental health, child development and prevention.

Linck is an accredited multi-service agency that responds to the unique dynamics of our families. We support the well-being and safety of our children and their families through evidence-based practices and collaboration with community partners. Together, Linck employees strive to foster an environment that encourages positive growth, professional development and progressive change.

Chatham-Kent has a population in excess of 110,000 and is ideally situated mid-way between Windsor and London on the shores of Lake Erie.

Do you have a flexible schedule and an interest in helping children in our community?

Linck Child, Youth & Family Supports ("Linck") requires **Volunteer Drivers**. These are casual (no set hours) volunteer positions, beginning as soon as possible.

Volunteer Drivers support the agency by transporting children involved with Linck services to and from visits, appointments, or placements using agency vehicles.

Drivers ensure children travel safely, arrive on time, and are left in the care of a responsible adult. Volunteers carry agency identification, follow program policies, confidentiality, and security requirements; while communicating any concerns to the Volunteer Drive Coordinator.

This flexible role allows volunteers to accept driving assignments based on their availability while providing an important service that supports children and families in Chatham-Kent and surrounding areas.

Qualifications:

- Valid Class 'G' driver's license with a safe driving record;
- minimum \$1,000,000 vehicle liability insurance;
- non-smoking vehicle;
- ability to install, lift, and carry child car seats;
- patient, friendly, non-judgmental attitude with strong reliability and punctuality;
- comfortable working with children who may experience stress or behavioral challenges;
- successful completion of agency screening process including police 'vulnerable sector' check and driving abstract;
- completion of initial car seat training and participation in annual training clinics.
